



## Public Input Common Themes

### How has public input been factored in to the evaluation of these five options?

Public input was one of the major inputs used in the analysis of the five options. Since December 2015, the Green Line team has been working with communities and stakeholders in the Centre City and the north leg of the line to learn about what they value, and what challenges and opportunities they see with each of the options in the Centre City.

### Common themes from Calgarians

- People felt it was important to maintain traffic, pedestrian and cyclist connections in the downtown core.
- People indicated the underground option would provide the best opportunity for future development in downtown.
- Many expressed concern about the visual and environmental impacts of a new bridge over Prince's Island Park.
- Some people indicated that street-level LRT would provide opportunities to improve sidewalks and pedestrian amenities.
- Concerns regarding the visual impact of an elevated LRT guideway in the Centre City were expressed.
