Profile: Caroline	What does this person NOTICE in the park?

She left her job</p> <p data-bbox="203 552 773 972">because of feeling unwell. She ended up staying with her parents, but it didn't work out so she went to stay with friends. One night she had a panic attack and her friends asked her to leave. Since then she has been sleeping at a shelter during the nights and getting access to help and services in the daytime. Caroline loves the park as she is welcomed there but has found it difficult to be in other spaces where people might be judging her or she is not welcomed.</p>

Profile: Kim	What does this person NOTICE in the park?

There have been many challenges since arriving, such as finding affordable housing, leaving behind all his extended family and friends, learning the English language and adapting to Canadian culture in order to succeed in a new job, communicate with colleagues and build new relationships.</p>

Profile: Emma	What does this person NOTICE in the park?
<div></div> <p>Emma is 16 years old and loves to hang out with friends in the community. One barrier is that she does not have a lot of spending money so the places she goes to have to be free. At times she feels unsafe or unwelcomed in spaces which make it uncomfortable for her and her friends to be. When her and her friends are out they enjoy spaces that they can share with friends, family, and strangers. Emma especially enjoys being able to sit around, to relax, to chat, play, practice group sports, or just walk and hang out with friends.</p>	
How does this person FEEL in the park?	What might this person want to change in the park to have a better experience?

Profile: Valerie	What does this person NOTICE in the park?
<div><p>Valerie is 69 years old and has lived in the community for the last 35 years. She has raised her kids here and her grandchildren now live close by. She is looking to age in place and is planning on finding a home that will accommodate her needs which include no yard work and smaller space. Valerie enjoys being able to get to the grocery store and other shops easily. She enjoys spending time outdoors in spaces where she can meet other friends or just spend some time alone reading or people watching.</p></div>

Profile: Leila	What does this person NOTICE in the park?

She relies partially on her sight, so some visual cues can be used particularly when the signs use Braille and are large and contrasting in colour. Leila also uses textures and audible signals to navigate the world, so increasing the use of these elements can help make a space easier to get around.</p>	
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
