

# **Centre Street N Existing Issues**

To better understand the

opportunities and constraints of the Centre Street N corridor, a detailed exploration of the existing conditions was undertaken and a number of observations of existing issues were made. These observations will inform how the corridor can be improved by Green Line construction.

### Lack of Streetscape Character + Amenities

## Uncomfortable Pedestrian Crossings
