Ramsay-Inglewood Station Area Improvements: What We Did & What's Next

We've reviewed all of the feedback provided and worked with our Consultants to create design concepts for the streetscape improvements and a new Greenway link from Ramsay-Inglewood Station to the Elbow River. The project team will continue with Detailed Design in Fall 2022 and begin construction in 2023 (contingent on funding approval by Council). Inglewood Bird Sanctuary Reconnection Project

Construction resumes in August

Construction in the north end of the Sanctuary will resume in August to complete the channels that will reconnect the lagoon to the Bow River. Reconnecting the lagoon to the river will provide a continuous supply of fresh water and create a passage to prevent fish from becoming trapped in the lagoon. It will also reduce the risk of the main channel of the Bow River being diverted through the park, which could result in the lagoon tripling in width, potentially harming the park, Colonel Walker House and the lagoon. We will also be constructing the new pedestrian crossing.

Trail Closures

- Trail A will remain closed.
- Trail B will be open until late-September.

- Expect pathway delays mid-September to late-December.
- Replacement of the lagoon outlets and the remaining restoration work will take place mid-September to late-December in the south end of the Sanctuary.
- During this time trucks will use a section of the Bow River Pathway to deliver materials. Pathway users should plan for potential 15-minute delays.
