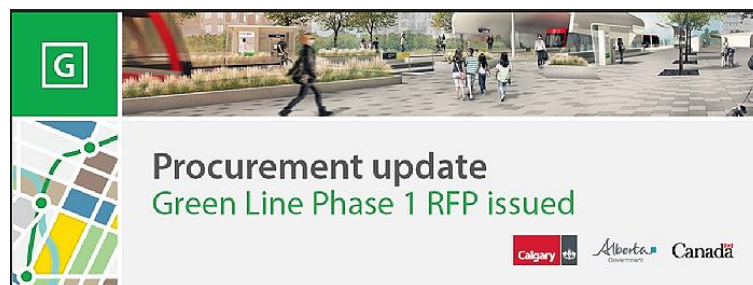




Inglewood/ Ramsay City Projects Update – Sept. 27 2022

See below for important updates on projects in and near the Inglewood and Ramsay communities.



Green Line LRT Update

As the largest infrastructure investment in Calgary's history, with \$5.5B in unprecedented contributions from all three levels of government, the Green Line LRT will shape mobility for generations.

Phase 1 of Green line, from Shepard to Eau Claire, will connect the Southeast to Downtown and into the existing Red and Blue lines and four MAX BRT routes building 13 stations, 18km of LRT track and three park and ride facilities.

This phase alone delivers almost 20,000 new direct and supporting jobs, provides new LRT access to Calgarians through more than 50,000 daily boardings and removes 26,750 GHGs annually. The economic impact of this investment will directly benefit local contractors, trades and suppliers while delivering over \$2.2B in long-term city-shaping benefits.

When people ask "when is Green Line construction starting", the answer is that it has. Constructing mega projects, like Green Line, starts with early works construction to make way for the main infrastructure.

Phase 1 early work includes over \$300 million in utility, road, sidewalk, pathway and other infrastructure upgrades and projects such as remediation of two landfill sites and a tunnel under existing railway tracks. Early works in the southeast are complete with the focus now on the Beltline and Downtown.

The Green Line is a long-term investment in Calgary's future and as our city grows, we will make sure we all can live, work and play in sustainable and affordable ways. For more information and to sign-up for updates, visit: www.calgary.ca/greenline

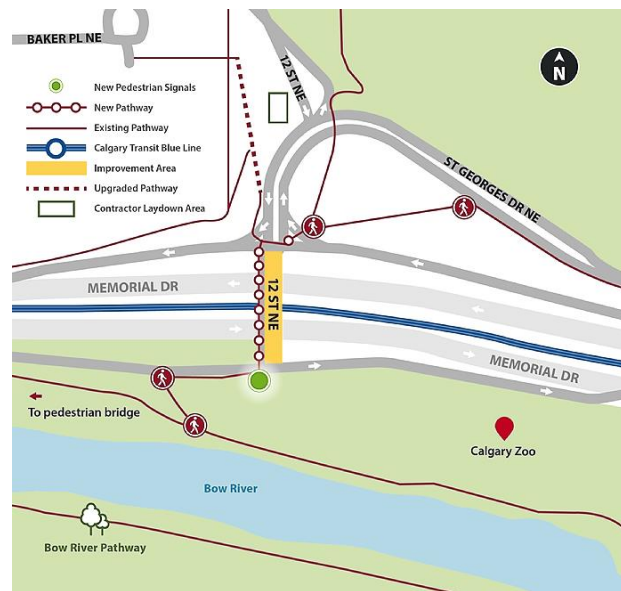
12 Street N.E. Bridge Construction

The way Calgarians get around is changing. more people are choosing to walk, scoot, skateboard, or cycle for their daily commute to work or school, for errands and for fun. As a city, we want to provide convenient and attractive transportation choices for Calgarians of all ages and abilities.

The 12 Street N.E. mobility improvements project will provide a wider sidewalk for walking and wheeling, improved pedestrian crossings, and a better connection within the pathway and bikeway network.

Construction is underway and is expected to be complete by late 2022. One lane of traffic will be closed to vehicles to ensure crews can work efficiently and safely. Pedestrian detours are also in place. Please note any signage, barriers, and markings if you're travelling in the area.
